



Leinster championship 2024 SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSIs)

1 RULES

- 1.1 These Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSIs) are to be read in conjunction with the current IODAI Major Event Sailing Instructions (MESIs). If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race or MESI and these SSIs, these SSIs shall prevail.
- 2 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS
- 2.1 The official notice board is located at MYC Optimist Leinster's 2024
- 2.2 The race office is located at MYC, Broadmeadows. Telephone 086-2599531, email rearcommodore@myc.ie
- 2.3 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate on VHF radio channel #72.
- 3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE
- 3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at main mast.
- 4 RACING AREA
- 5.1 The racing area for main fleet is NNW of the clubhouse. Regatta fleet will be NE of clubhouse
- 5 MARKS
- 5.1 Marks for main fleet will be yellow pencil marks. The Main fleet Finish line pin end mark will be a yellow round mark.
- 6 OBSTRUCTIONS
- 6.1 There are no designated obstructions in the Race Area other than those set out in SI11.





7 THE START

7.1 The starting line is between a red and white staff on the committee boat at the starboard end and a red and white staff displaying an orange flag on the port-end starting boat.

9 THE FINISH

9.1 The finishing line is between a staff displaying a blue flag on the finishing boat at the starboard end and the course side of the port end finishing mark.

11 OFFICIAL VESSELS

11.1 Official vessels, other than those listed below, will carry *red flag*. Jury boats will carry a yellow flag.
