SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSIs)

- 1 RULES
- 1.1 These Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSIs) are to be read in conjunction with the current IODAI Major Event Sailing Instructions (MESIs). If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race or MESI and these SSIs, these SSIs shall prevail.
- 2 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS
- 2.1 Notices to competitors shall be posted on the IODAI WhatsApp groups.
- 2.2 Competitors briefing for Regatta Fleet sailors will be held at 10:15 on Saturday morning at the event marquee located on the Carlisle Pier.

- 2.3 A safety briefing for rescue boats/ support boat crews will be held at 0900 at the event marquee located on the Carlisle Pier.
- 2.4 On the water, the Regatta Fleet race committee intends to monitor and communicate on VHF radio channel <73> with channel <79> being used as a backup safety channel. Any changes to these channels will be updated in the competitors briefing or will be broadcast on channel <73> before the first warning signal.
- 3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE
- 3.1 Signals made ashore shall be displayed at the Main Mast in front of the clubhouse.

5 RACING AREA

5.1 The racing area is the environs of Dublin Bay or within Dun Laoghaire Harbour.

6 MARKS AND COMMITTEE BOATS

- 6.1 The course race marks will be: Marks 1, 2 & 3 orange buoy. Pin end will be a candy striped buoy. The finish mark will also be a candy striped buoy.
- 6.2 Start & Finishing Boat 45ft, white sailing yacht called Minerva
- 7 THE START
- 7.1 The starting line is between a flag pole on the committee boat at the starboard end and a candy striped mark on the port-end of the line.

8 THE FINISH

8.1 The finishing line is between a staff displaying a blue flag on the finishing boat at the starboard end and the course side of the port end finishing mark.

9 HEARING REQUESTS

1.1 Protests / requests for redress shall be lodged via the Events page on

- 9.1 The protest time limit shall be 30 minutes after all boats have tallied in or after the Race Committee has accounted for any boats not tallied already.
- 10 THE COURSE
- 10.1 The course will be a triangular course. The diagrams in Appendix A show the course, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which the marks are to be passes and the side on which mark is to be left.
- 10 OFFICIAL VESSELS
- 10.1 Jury boats shall display a yellow flag.
- 12 [DP] SUPPORT TEAMS
- 12.1 Only IODAI and nominated local club coaches shall provide support to the Regatta fleets and they must be registered with the race office.
