SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSIs)

1 RULES

1.1 These Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSIs) are to be read in conjunction with the current IODAI Major Event Sailing Instructions (MESIs). If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race or MESI and these SSIs, these SSIs shall prevail.

2 **COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS**

- 2.1 The official notice board is located inside EABC Clubhouse. Alerts regarding notices may be made on the <u>IODAI What's App groups.</u>
- 2.2 The race office is located at the top of the stairs above the Clubhouse main hall.
- 2.3 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate on VHF radio channels: VHF Ch37 (Main Fleet), VHF Ch80 (Regatta Fleet), VHF Ch80 (Regatta Coaching Fleet)

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole at the front of the Clubhouse.

4 RACING AREA

- 4.1 The Main Fleet racing area is within Larne Lough, south of EABC.
- 4.2 The Regatta Racing Fleet area is within Larne Lough, close to EABC.
- 4.3 The Regatta Coaching Fleet area is within the moorings area off EABC.

5 MARKS

Marks will be as follows:

- 5.1 Main fleet racing marks will be Yellow Inflatables.
- 5.2 The pin end of the starting line will be a danbuoy with a red flag.
- 5.3 The pin end of the finishing line, except when a race is shortened at a mark of the course, will be a small blue buoy.







- 5.4 Regatta Racing Fleet will be orange inflatable marks and a small orange mark for the pin end
- 5.5 Regatta Coaching Fleet will use red and blue training marks.

6 **OBSTRUCTIONS**

6.1 There are no designated obstructions in the Race Area.

7 THE START

7.1 The starting line is between the mast displaying an orange flag on the race committee signal vessel at the starboard end and the danbuoy with a red flag.

8 THE FINISH

8.1 The finishing line is between a pole displaying a blue flag on the finishing boat and a blue inflatable buoy.

9 **HEARING REQUESTS**

9.1 Hearing request forms are available from the race office.

10 **OFFICIAL VESSELS**

10.1 Official vessels, other than those listed below, will carry numbered YELLOW flags. Jury boat(s) will carry a white flag with the word "JURY" printed.

Descriptions of Committee Vessels as follows:

- 10.2 The Main Fleet Start Vessel will be a White Hulled 32' Yacht called "ARTEMIS".
- 10.3 The Main Fleet Finish Vessel will be a white hulled motorboat called "CAHER ISLE".

11 [DP] SUPPORT TEAMS

11.1 Support person vessels shall be identified with a RED numbered flag.
