

IODAI Sprint Series 2026 – National YC

SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSIs)

1 RULES

1.1 These Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSIs) are to be read in conjunction with the current IODAI Major Event Sailing Instructions (MESIs). If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race or MESI and these SSIs, these SSIs shall prevail.

2 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

2.1 The official notice board is located at

2.2 The race office is located in the Grannard room at the National YC

2.3 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate on VHF radio channel 74.

3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the secondary club flag mast.

3.2. Flag D to warning signal not less than 30 mins

4 RACING AREA

5.1 The racing area is Dun Laoghaire harbour.

5 COURSE AND MARKS

5.1 The course will be Course B, Optimist Worlds Course as set out in the MESIs with a slight modification. The reach mark (Mark 2) will be the port side of the finish line.

5.2 the windward (mark 1) and the reach mark (mark 2) will be orange inflatable triangle. The gate will be identified by two yellow inflatable sticks

6 THE START

6.1 The starting line is between the main mast of the committee boat (a beneteau 33.7) at the starboard end and the pin-end dan buoy carrying an orange flag.

6.2. Orange flag to Warning 1 min

6.3. Both junior and senior fleet will be started at the same time with class flag O (only one start per race)

7 THE FINISH

7.1 The finishing line is between a staff displaying a blue flag on the finishing boat at the starboard end and the reach mark (mark 2) on the port end.

9 OFFICIAL VESSELS

Jury boats if any, will carry a yellow flag.

Committee Vessel is a Beneteau 33.7 yacht

Finishing boat will be a RIB carrying a blue flag on a mast

10 SCHEDULE

10.1 Briefing will take place at 1100 under the club balcony.

10.2 FG will be 1130.

10.3 Up to 4 races are scheduled. 2 races will constitute a series for the day as per NOR.

Discards as per NOR.

11. TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

11.1 the target time for a race is 25 mins. Failing to reach the target time will not be ground for redress

11.2 The time limit to finish a race is 45 mins

11.3 The finish window after the winner of the race is 10 mins.

12. BERTHING AND LAUNCHING

12.1 NYC and visiting boats will launch and recover from the NYC slip

12.2 RstGYC boats will launch from the RstGYC slip
