Our Friendly marshal, Joe will be there on your arrival on Friday evening and Saturday morning to show you where to go for boat parking and registration.

Registration: will be open upstairs in the Club bar on Friday evening from 17.30- 20.00 and on Saturday from 08.30 to 09.30.

Boat parking: This will be in front of the club for main fleet and in front of the boat shed for Regatta coached and race.

Car parking: The harbour in Dunmore East doesn't have many parking spaces. It is best if you drop sailors and gear down on Saturday morning and then park in Shanon, (first right turn (at East Pier) after you turn down the Harbour from Dock Road). If you are staying in the village, walking down would be your best option.

Trailer parking: All trailers will be stored in the Harbour area, and you will be advised where to bring them after you unload the boats

Rib launch and recovery: If possible, it is recommended that all ribs are launched on arrival on Friday evening. Ask at registration, and they will advise what mooring you can tie up to for the weekend. Any late ribs can be launched between 09.00 – 10.00 on Saturday morning.

Retrieval of ribs will be at the discretion of the Beachmaster on Sunday afternoon, or after all fleets have come ashore.
